## GRESHAM VILLAGE SCHOOL AND NURSERY PROGRESSION IN OUTDOOR LEARNING SKILLS

We use our adapted version of the **Wild Passport progressive skills curriculum** to provide the framework for the teaching of outdoor learning skills from Years 1 to 6. Children are assessed throughout the year and are presented with a certificate if they show proficiency in the skills at their level. The levels are:

- 1. Beginner
- 2. Advanced Beginner
- 3. Intermediate
- 4. Proficient
- 5. Expert

The acquisition of these skills is largely sequential with plenty of opportunities to apply and practice. In the first year of introducing the programme, children will need to acquire basic outdoor learning skills, so many will not be working at the level we intend. Implementation in the first year should be as following:
